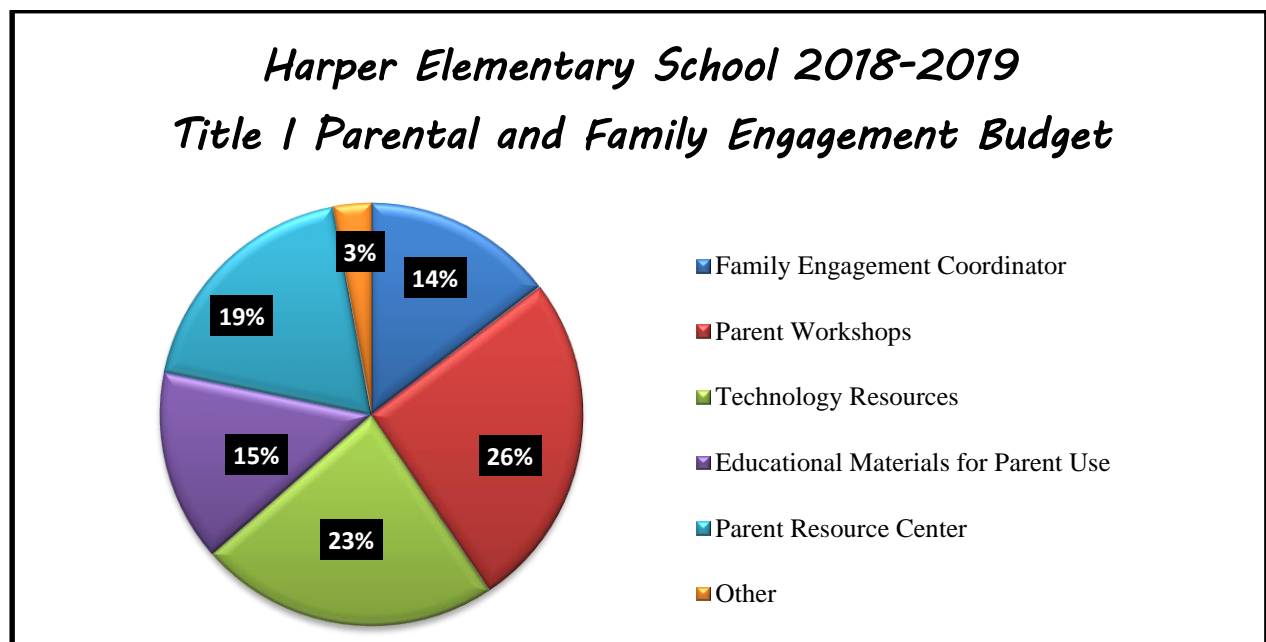

5. Parents asked for more interpreter and translation services at parent events.

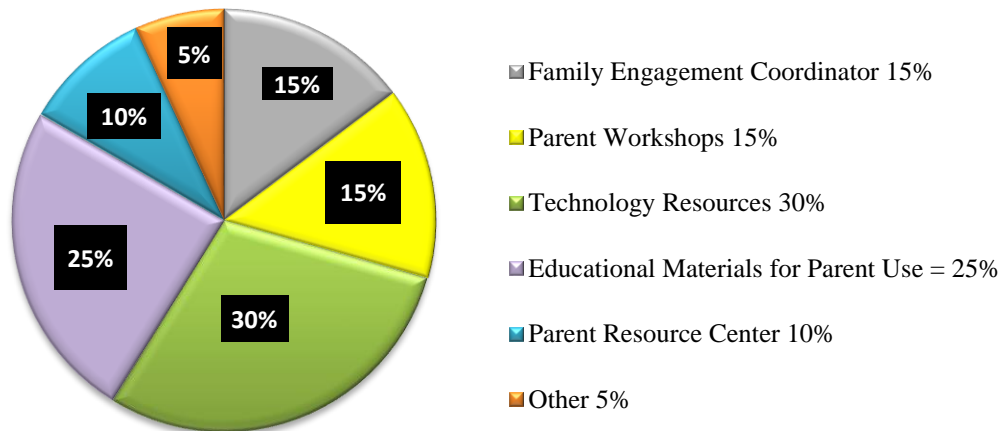
Last year, we had **\$3,604** in the Title I Parental Involvement Budget. We spent the money this way:
