- The School- Based Health Center is a collaborative partnership with Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) and The Family Health Centers of Georgia
- Personnel from CCPS and The Family Health Centers of Georgia have met regarding the implementation since June 2014.
- The students and staff at North Clayton High School, Charles Drew High School, Riverdale High School, Northcutt Elementary School, Pointe South Elementary, King Elementary, Church Street Elementary, Lake Ridge Elementary, Harper Elementary, Oliver Elementary, Northcutt Elementary, North Clayton Middle School, Riverdale Middle School, Sequoyah Middle School and West Clayton Elementary School may be served at the SBHC.
- The hours of operation are from 8:00am-4:00pm Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8:00a.m-5:00pm.
- The staff at the SBHC include: Behavioral Health Professional, Physician, Nurse Intake Personnel
- The services will be: Hypertension Therapy, Diabetes Management, and Behavioral Health referrals, Chronic Disease Management, Health Education, Nutritional Counseling, Dental, Vision, Youth Weight Reduction, Immunizations by appointment only, School and Sports Physicals by appointment only, sick visits, and well child checks.
