



Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Georgia Tech Women's Basketball team would like to invite your child to participate in their annual "Jacket 2 Jacket" reading program. Jacket 2 Jacket is an initiative to promote and encourage children to learn through reading. The longstanding program was refreshed in 2015 thanks to a program sponsorship from Georgia United Credit Union! Additionally, we are ecstatic that the Atlanta Dream will be partnering with us again this year for this initiative. We are excited for the new prizes and incentives that will surround the program! It will be held in conjunction with the start of the Women's Basketball season. All elementary and middle school students from schools in Metro Atlanta are eligible to participate.

Requirements:

- Each student will record the number of pages read daily from **October 1 to October 31, 2018**, with the parent or guardian initialing the reading sheet provided. Pages read to the student by a parent or guardian may also be included. Students can read books or newspapers (one full newspaper page counts as two reading program pages). Please total the number of pages read on the reading sheet below.
- The name of the book is requested to provide information to the teacher as to the type of books the children are reading.

Awards:

Students participating in the program are eligible for several prizes, including a plaque, bookstore gift certificate, free admission to a Georgia Tech Women's Basketball game and recognition at halftime of the Women's Basketball game in January against an ACC Opponent (TBD). Every student who participates in the program will gain free admission to the **Georgia Tech vs. ACC Opponent (TBD)** game in January and every child in attendance at the game will receive a Georgia United goodie bag. In addition, the top classes with the most pages read will receive a visit from the Georgia Tech Women's Basketball team in the Spring Semester. Prizes will be awarded for the following categories:
